ORDINANCE NO. <u>24-2022</u>

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VACATION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PLAIN CITY RUNNING BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND BIGELOW AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Village of Plain City has received a petition pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 723.04 requesting the vacation of a public alley running between Main Street and Bigelow Street; and

WHEREAS, the Village has reviewed the petitioned request to vacate the public alley described in the Petition; and

WHEREAS, the Petition has been signed by all abutting property owners of the territory proposed for vacation by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that the vacation of said alley will not be detrimental to the general interest of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Village has requested that a four (4) foot wide strip of land in the center of the proposed vacated alley, running between Main Street and Bigelow Avenue, be kept open as a pedestrian right-of-way and has requested an easement from each of the petitioners for said purposes; and

WHEREAS, the execution and recording of said easements is a condition precedent upon the vacation of said alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of Plain City, as follows:

- Section 1. The Village Council hereby approves the vacation of the public alley and associated public right-of-way depicted on the petition submitted, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.
- As a condition precedent to Section 1 of this Ordinance, petitioners shall each execute an easement to the Village of Plain City for the purpose of keeping a portion of the vacated alley open to pedestrian use. The execution and receipt of the easements is a condition precedent to the vacation of the alley and the Village will not proceed with forwarding vacation documents to the County unless and until the easements have been fully executed and received by the Village.
- Section 3. Upon execution of the easements, the Village Council herby authorizes the Fiscal Officer to record a certified copy of this Ordinance and record the same with the Madison County Recorder's Office. Immediately following the recording of this Ordinance shall be the recording of the easements.
- **Section 4.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of

Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

The legislative authority may include in one ordinance the change of name, vacation, or narrowing of more than one street, avenue, or alley. The original ordinance or a certified copy thereof shall be recorded in the official records of the county recorder.
